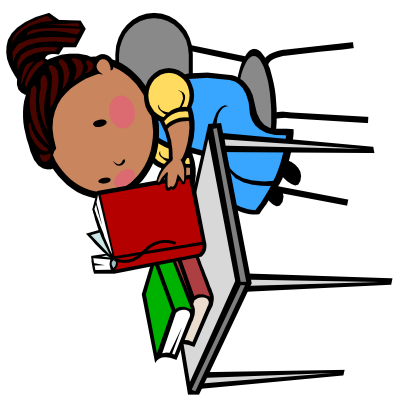

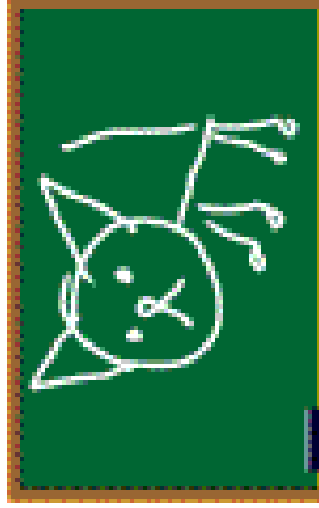

- The Kindergarten Program addresses the developmental needs of the children before they enter grade one:
- * Young children develop skills, knowledge, and attitudes that prepare them for subsequent learning.
 - * Through early intervention and strategies, young children with special needs develop skills, knowledge and attitudes that will prepare them for future learning.
 - * Young children build a shared set of experiences and participate as active partners in learning.





The purpose of Kindergarten is to provide appropriate learning experiences that meet the diverse needs of children, and to prepare them for entry into grade one.

- * Each child's unique background experiences, their characteristics, interests, abilities and needs, will serve as the basis for continual growth and progress in all developmental areas: emotional, social, intellectual, creative and physical.
