**ALL SCHOOLS TO OPEN ON TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 6, 2011**

**SELKIRK SECONDARY SCHOOL - Grades 8 - 12 (250-427-4827)**

On Tuesday, September 6 all grades 8, 9, 10 and 11 students assemble in the gymnasium at 8:45 a.m. for instruction and timetables. All grade 8 – 11 students will run through a shortened timetable and will then be dismissed by 11:50 a.m. Grade 12 students will attend an assembly in the gymnasium at 11:15 a.m. for instructions, timetables and graduation requirements. They will also be dismissed at 11:50 a.m. Bus pick up will be at 12:10.

Students should bring with them:

1. Pen, pencil and notebook.
2. Students are asked to bring their own COMBINATION lock (Dudley recommended). The school does have a small supply available for \$7.00 in the office.
3. Fees - \$55.00. This fee includes the cost of the 2011/12 Yearbook (\$35.00) and student council activities (\$20.00). Cost of school photographs is not included in this fee. Purchase of photographs is optional and price lists will be available in September.
