STAFFING

POLICY:

- 1. The Board of Education ("Board") is committed to providing a staff of high quality, having good professional qualifications, and high ethical standards. The Board will endeavour to hire the best candidates available and to assign them to appropriate positions.
- 2. The Board will be responsible for maintaining a staffing policy and ratifying all appointments and transfers.
- 3. In accordance with section 65 of the <u>School Act</u>, the Board delegates to the Superintendent and/or his/her delegates the power to appoint staff; and the power to discipline, suspend, or dismiss staff except where there is a limitation of that power which is contained in the collective agreement or in the School Act.

INFORMATION RELEVANT TO POLICY

Section 65 (2) A Board may:

(c) delegate specific and general administrative and management duties to one or more of its employees.

8.1 Delegation of Duties and Powers

WHEREAS Section 65 of the *School Act* allows for the delegation of administration and management duties to employees:

THAT the Board of School Trustees of School District No. 6 (Rocky Mountain) delegates to the Superintendent and/or his/her delegates the power to appoint staff; and the power to discipline, suspend or dismiss staff except where there is a limitation of that power which is contained in the Collective Agreement or in the *School Act*.
