OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH AND SAFETY

POLICY:

The Board of Education "Board" is committed to providing a safe and healthy environment for its workers. To achieve this, our School District has established and will maintain an occupational health and safety program designed to prevent injuries and disease. It is also a belief of the Board that the focus on health and safety will also benefit students and the general public by providing a safe and healthy environment for all.

All workers share a responsibility with the Board to take reasonable care to protect their own health and safety and that of other persons in the workplace. Every worker is to protect the health and safety of themselves and other persons by working in compliance with School District safe work procedures and complying with those regulations applicable to their work.

In accordance with the <u>Workers Compensation Act</u> and <u>Occupational Health and Safety Regulations</u>, the Board shall provide a copy of this policy for inclusion in the School District's occupational health and safety program.
