## STRATEGIC AND POLICY ISSUES

✓ Ms. Shipka presented the Board with the proposed amendments for the following five (5) policies for third reading. Ms. Shipka indicated that all the proposed amendments are housekeeping or to correct minor grammatical errors. The Policy Committee recommended that the Board consider all five (5) policies for third and final reading and the Board approved all five (5) policies at third and final reading.

### **OPERATIONAL ISSUES**

✓ Mr. Culler presented the Board with the November and December 2021 budget utilization summaries. Mr. Culler discussed the results of the operations in detail indicating that the variances are largely due to certain COVID-19 related expenditures shifted from the operating fund that are now being funded by two new special purpose funds; one Provincial grant and a second Federal grant. Mr. Culler indicated that the amended budget will include the reallocation of expenses to these new special purpose funds. Mr. Culler responded to questions and the Chairperson thanked him for his presentation.

- ✓ Trustee Fearing reported that the BCSTA sub-committee for Indigenous Education has awarded five thousand dollars (\$5,000) to engage a retired superintendent to develop a BC Tripartite Agreement handbook that will be available for all Trustees across the Province.
- ✓ Trustee Thurgood-Sagal indicated that there will be a motion building meeting being held on Wednesday, January 13<sup>th</sup>, 2021. She indicated that there have been no motions circulated and that no motions have been prepared by our District.
