SD6 Board-Community Update on the activities of the Board of Education from the most recent regular meeting

STRATEGIC AND POLICY ISSUES

- ✓ The Board approved all three readings of Policy 4510 Workplace Bullying & Harassment. The amendment discussed is a housekeeping item making a change in reference to the website.
- ✓ The Board approved first reading of Bylaw 1 Procedural Bylaw. The amendment discussed is to change the dates of the inaugural meeting due to the timing of the Fall election requiring everything to be moved ahead one month.

OPERATIONAL ISSUES

- ✓ Mr. Culler reported on the January budget utilization summary indicating that the results of the operations for the period ended January 31, 2018 are as expected.
- ✓ The Board approved all three readings of the 2017 2018 Amended Annual Budget.
- ✓ Ms. Turner presented the board with information regarding the McCreary Centre Adolescent Youth Survey, which will be administered with parent permission to students in Grades 7-12.
- ✓ The Board approved adoption of the 2018-19 and 2019-20 School Calendars after considering recommendations of staff based on the community input received. There was also a change because of the Government decision to change BC Family Day in 2019, to align it with other Provinces.

- ✓ BC School Trustees Association Trustee Fearing and Chairperson Byklum provided information regarding the funding model review that will be discussed at the February 16 and 17, 2018 Provincial Council meeting.
- ✓ BC School Trustees Association Kootenay Boundary Branch Chairperson Byklum provided her report to the board.
- ✓ Public School Employers Association Trustee Campbell provided the Board with an update from the BCPSEA AGM held in January 2018 indicating that elections were held for the new Board of Directors. The Kootenay-Boundary Branch representative is Rebecca Huscroft (SD8).
