



POLICY 2100
SCHOOL CATCHMENT AREAS

POLICY:

The Board of Education (“Board”) has the legal duty, after considering the recommendations of the Superintendent to assign students to various schools in the District, and power to divide the District into areas for the purpose of assigning students to schools.

Students shall normally attend the schools designated by the Board for their particular catchment area. For purposes of school attendance, a student’s residence shall be considered that of their parents or legal guardian.

Parents may request permission for their children to attend schools outside their normal catchment area. When such permission is obtained, parents will be expected to assume responsibility for transportation, or any additional costs incurred by cross-boundary transfer.
