



POLICY 7100

STUDENT CONDUCT ON BUSES

POLICY:

The Board of Education (“Board”) believes that the safety of the students riding the school bus is of prime concern, and that riding the school bus is a privilege and not a right. This privilege may be withdrawn at any time if there is a violation of the policy, district practice, or if the safety of the bus passengers is endangered by student action.

Students are responsible for their actions and shall comply with the code of conduct for bus students found in district practice 7100 and with school and District codes of conduct.
