Teacher Teaching on Call (TTOC) Extended Health and Dental benefits

School District No.6 – Rocky Mountain offers TTOCs access to health and dental benefits. The terms of eligibility and process for enrolling are included below. If you have questions regarding your health and dental benefits please contact the districts benefits administrator (benefits@sd6.bc.ca)

Eligibility

To be eligible for TTOC extended health and dental benefits you must registered as TTOC with School District No.6 – Rocky Mountain. You may opt into the extended health or dental plans or both.

Enrolment

You must enroll in the benefit plans by no later than September 30th of each year. Coverage will be effective starting October 1st. TTOCs hired after September 30th are not eligible for benefits until September the following year as the annual enrolment window is September 1 to 30.

TTOC Extended Health benefits


TTOC Extended Health coverage is offered through the provincial TTOC extended health care plan, administered directly by Pacific Blue Cross. A TTOC eligibility form and the TTOC Ex health application form will need to be completed and sent to the benefits administrator (benefits@sd6.bc.ca). HR will then complete Part 8 of the form and return it to you to send to PBC. You can choose to pay monthly premiums via credit card or pre authorized withdrawal from your bank account. TTOC Dental benefits


TTOC dental coverage is offered through SD6 teacher dental benefits. The TTOC dental application form will need to be completed and returned to the benefits administrator (benefits@sd6.bc.ca). Payment for the compulsory 12 months premium cost is to be in full via cheque or etransfer to the district. Monthly rates are on forms. This form will need to be completed and returned to the benefits administrator with your payment. 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Cancelling coverage

You must be enrolled in the TTOC plan for at least 12 months before cancelling your coverage, unless you obtain group coverage through another plan, or if you become ineligible because you are no longer an active TTOC. If you were enrolled and you cancelled your coverage you will not have the option of rejoining the plan at a future time.
