9.1 Budget utilization report:

Alan Rice

Mr. Rice presented the Board of Education a report on year-to-date operating expenditures compared to budget and prior year. Expenditures to date are below budget by 2.62% and greater than the prior year by \$2,568,000 for the same timeframe. The operating variance of actual to budget for year-to-date is considered reasonable.

9.2 Technology update:

Trent Dolgopol and Nathan Skretting

The Board of Education was provided an update on SD6 information technology changes and advancements. Increased expectations, increased devices/ratios, higher service levels, strategic planning and implementation, and improvements to network infrastructure all require strategic allocation of resources. The number of student devices has grown by 32% from 1700 devices to 2250 devices. In conclusion, the Information Technology Department is making progress towards the District goals outlined in the Technology Plan.

Trustee Thurgood Sagal reported on a number of items to the Board of Education. She reported on the BCSTA and Ministry of Education and Child Care online session "Working with People" held on March 30, 2023.
