PRESENTATIONS

Composting in Kimberley Schools • Ms. Sarah DeRuiter, Learning Services Teacher at Lindsay Park Elementary School presented on a pilot project to introduce a composting program to Kimberley area schools. Initiative falls under "Stewardship for the Future" in the Board's Strategic Plan. With the current efforts, staff are at capacity for current program. Participating classrooms would have garbage/recycling/compost with central location in hallways which will be managed by the custodial teams 1-2 times a week. City of Kimberley would pick up bins. The Board thanked Ms. DeRuiter for her presentation.
